

<b>Overview</b> The lesson will introduce pupils to the Micro-Tyco Challenge and give them an overview of what they will be expected to do over the course of the challenge.		<b>Required Time</b> 30 mins

Activity Suggested Time	Steps	Resources
<b>Introduction</b> 10 minutes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tell pupils they will be taking part in the Micro---Tyco Challenge.</li> <li>2. Talk pupils through the overview of Micro-Tyco</li> <li>3. Explain how you want Micro---Tyco to work within their class time and/or as an extra—curricular activity.</li> <li>4. Get your pupils to guess what the Micro---Tyco School Record is.</li> <li>5. Then play the Video on Slide 7. This should inspire them with the idea of what is possible by aiming high!</li> <li>6. Explain to pupils though that Micro---Tyco is not about how much you make but how much you grow.</li> </ol>	PPT 1
<b>Getting Started Task</b> 10 minutes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7. The aim of this task is to share what other teams have done with their £1 and get pupils thinking about what they would do with their £1.</li> <li>8. It is important to impress upon the pupils at this stage that they will get lots more help generating ideas in later lessons. <i>This activity is just to start them thinking.</i></li> </ol>	PPT 1
